


FINDING ROSENDALE

Why: Ulster County Transportation Council is providing funding to the Town of Rosendale to develop concept plans to improve circulation, accessibility, parking, and safety for pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists in and around the NYS Route 213 or "Main Street District" of Rosendale. The plan, nicknamed "Finding Rosendale", is consistent with complete streets concepts as well as community goals and expectations. The purpose of this meeting is to allow the community to comment on the study including final draft designs for welcome and directional signage for the Town.

Who Should Attend: Local Citizens, Business Owners, Property Owners, Non-Profit Organizations, Government Officials, Developers and Realtors, Lenders, and Special Interest and Advocacy Groups.
