

TOWN OF ROSENDALE  
TOWN BOARD MEETING  
MAY 11, 2016

Supervisor Walsh called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge to the Flag at the Rondout Municipal Center. A moment of silence was observed for Dorothy Boodakin, Travis Sheeley, Johanna Hill, and Chet Beesimer.

Supervisor Walsh made a motion to approve the April minutes with the spelling corrections, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilman Hughes. ROLL VOTE: 4 YES.

PUBLIC COMMENTS/ COMMUNITY EVENTS: Jim Damon a Rosendale resident suggested when a property owner is renting their property for events or a festival they should be present at the time of the festival for any issues that may arise. Supervisor Walsh said this is something she will go over with the town attorney and can maybe add it as a condition during the application process. Kathleen Wiacek, also a Rosendale resident, addressed her questions and concerns with the board about the Tillson School project. She asked questions she was unsure of from last week's meeting. The Board answered her questions and addressed her concerns.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: Councilman Pryslopsi reported the April books for the Justice Court all reconciled. The court also received a JCAP grant and was able to purchase a new entry door for the prisoners, cameras, and a walk through metal detector. The Environmental Commission is still working on the Pilgrim Pipeline study and there will also be a creek event in September. The Rondout Municipal center will have surveillance camera soon, swipe card access for people renting out rooms or the gym, our Town Historian has hung some pictures in our hallway, and the Blackboard Bistro is now open and serving food. The Transfer Station took in \$2,842.65 and are also looking for a seasonal employee 2 days a week. Councilman Hughes reported the pool is moving along very well and the underground work is almost finished. The Bathhouse has been a slow process and we are receiving funding by NY Rising. The Planning Board took in \$50.00 and their meeting is tomorrow at 7:00 PM in this building. The Building Department took in \$3,513.00 and gave out 8 new permits. The DOT has requested an insurance bond for

sidewalk work to be ADA compliant by the State which is holding up the work for the Water Main to start. Water and Sewer took in a total of \$58,214.41 for the month of April.

Councilwoman Metzger reported the Dog Control taking in \$286.26, Youth Department \$6,521.00, Recreation \$2,597.75 and the Police Department \$20.00. The Youth department is looking for Volunteers to help with the car show and they are also hiring for camp counselors and life guards. The recreation center has an inverter out for their solar. Councilwoman Metzger made a motion to pay for the inverter out of the town's solar account, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Supervisor Walsh. ROLL VOTE: 4 YES. Councilwoman Metzger said the UCIAF (Ulster County Italian American Foundation) want to build a bocce court and donate it to the town. Supervisor Walsh said the Recreation Commission can reach out to them. Councilwoman Metzger read a letter to the board from Terry Gittens about her son Gerald Neal who was an avid basketball player at the courts in Rosendale. She wants to have the basketball courts in remembrance by her son. Supervisor Walsh said only with the conditions she provided. Councilwoman Metzger made a motion that the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale support the recommendation and conditions of the Recreation Commission based on the letter that was sent to the Town Board April 21, 2016 from the Recreation Commission for the proposed Basketball Court and dedication, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilman Hughes. ROLL VOTE: 4 YES. Grievance Day is May 24, 2016 from 2:00pm – 4:00 PM and also 7:00pm to 9:00pm for the Assessor. Councilman Hughes also said that Erik Hines is doing an amazing job as the Code Enforcement Officer. There has been a lot of rumbling about noise on Main Street and the code is available on the Town's website which is Code 47.
