# Town of Rosendale Pool Summer 2021

### **Pool Operations:**

- Season will run from July-August
- Pool Hours: 12:00 7:00 (subject to change based on attendance and available daylight)
- The maximum occupancy of the Rosendale Town Pool is capped at 200 people, consistent with the New York State Department of Health guidance. This number will allow for us to practice social distancing.
- Attendance is on a first come, first served basis.
- Town of Rosendale Pool will be opened **Everyone** town & non town residents.
- The Town of Rosendale reserves the right to close the pool based on attendance, and adherence to social distancing.
- Patrons must present ID to show proof of residency in the Town of Rosendale.
- Fees will remain the same:

# Wristbands:

- Wristbands are already pre-counted in increments of 200. They are paper-clipped together.
- All patrons will get the same color wristband for the day, regardless if they're a swimmer, or nonswimmer. This will help staff keep an accurate head count. Cashiers will be responsible for marking an "x" on the non-swimmer's wristband to signify the difference. A sharpie will be provided for them to do this.
- Once we have reached capacity at 200. Residents waiting will be allowed in once other others leave the pool area.

# **Pool Entry and Procedures:**

- The ticket booth will be opened for the purchase of daily passes.
- All patrons must adhere to social distancing guidelines while awaiting entry to the Town Pool. Social Distancing markers will be marked on the pavement.
- Patrons will purchase their tickets, get their temperatures checked, and receive their wristbands at the ticket booth. They will then exit the ticket booth, and proceed to the entrance gate. A staff member will be at the gate to greet them, and check for wristbands.
- Entrance gate is across from the pavilion.
- Patrons must come dressed ready to swim.
- Patrons may bring, and are encouraged to bring their own chairs.
- All patrons must wear a mask when entering the pool area, and may remove masks to swim.
- Chairs that are part of Town of Rosendale property *are not* to be moved as they are appropriately spaced for social distancing.
- Restrooms will be available.

## **Cleaning and Sanitizing:**

- Town staff will thoroughly clean pool facilities on a regular basis.
- Throughout the day, the restrooms will be temporarily be closed for cleaning.
- Soap will be available for hand washing in all restrooms.
- Hand sanitizer will be made available to patrons upon request.
- Town staff will disinfect lounge chairs between uses upon request by patrons.

### **Social Distancing & Face Coverings:**

- Patrons are asked to maintain six feet of social distance throughout the facility including in the water.
- Family units who arrive together may remain together in close proximity.
- Signage will be posted throughout the grounds to remind guests of social distancing measures.
- Patrons must wear face coverings as a condition of entry to the Town Pool.
- Once patrons have reached their destination/area, face masks may be removed.
- Face coverings should never be worn in the pool.
- Town staff must wear face masks unless in the pool.
- Guards do not need to wear a mask while actively guarding their stations; however, when rotating they must wear a mask.

#### **Concession Stand:**

- Pre-packaged silverware, wrapped straws, and single-serve condiments will be available.
- Social distancing must be followed when waiting in line at the concession stand for food orders.
- No patrons will be allowed inside the concession stand.
  - The counter will run across the entry way, and customers may choose their food/snack choices outside the door.
  - The cashiers will assist the customers by getting their food, and bringing it to them.
  - A sign with menu options and prices will be visible to customers.
