RESOLUTION – PURCHASE OF A NEW HYUNDAI 930TM LOADER FOR HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Rosendale Highway Department has the need to replace the current wheel loader due to wear and tear and increased maintenance issues; and

WHEREAS, Superintendent Robert Gallagher has received three (3) quotes for a wheel loader from:

Westchester Tractor, Inc. for \$169,980.00

C.N. Wood Co., Inc. for \$183,549.00

A. Montano Co., Inc. for \$155,468.00; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent Robert Gallagher has researched such equipment and recommends purchasing the Hyundai wheel loader from A. Montano Co., Inc. of 571 Route 212 Saugerties, NY 12477 whose paperwork has been attached and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Town will be trading in the current 2011 JCB 416HT wheel loader for \$20,000; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this piece of equipment will enhance the Highways efficiency with less maintenance issues and has a total cost of \$155,468.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the cost of said equipment will be based on five (5) yearly payments of \$17,276.25 per year with a down payment of \$60,000.00 coming out of unexpended funds and the trade in of the old wheel loader of \$20,000.00. All future payments of \$17,276.25 will come out of the Highway Equipment line DA5130.2; and
