WHEREAS, in the event of unforeseen cost overruns which may be associated with meeting contractual obligations, minimum wage increases, bond payments, improving facilities, funding health insurance expenses and unconfirmed Sales Tax and AIM revenue from State and County Government; it is necessary to have a local law in effect in order to override a New York State mandated "tax cap"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Rosendale is empowered to enact such local law, pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law § 3-c, which expressly authorizes the town board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of such local law, and subsequent passage of a resolution approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the town board; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale hereby schedules a public hearing on November 1, 2023 immediately following the public hearing for the 2024 Preliminary Budget at the Rondout Municipal Center at 1915 Lucas Avenue Cottekill, NY 12419, to consider the advisability of adopting such Local Law; and
