OLD BUSINESS:

- 1.**Prior meeting minutes:** R. Sorge moved to approve the minutes from the September 2023 meeting. Seconded by D. Hattenbrun. All in favor.
- 2. **Tennis/pickleball courts:** A ribbon -cutting ceremony was held prior to this meeting.
- 3.**Holiday tree**: D. Whitaker reports that the new tree has been planted. Replacement of rocks and grasses and installation of electric has been delayed as the town backhoe is not working. Attempts are being made to borrow one from another town.
- **4.Marquee/Ballfield lighting poles**: K. Carr reports that the projects have been delayed due to backorder of poles from Central Hudson. The poles are expected to arrive in 2 weeks and the electric work will be done for both projects will be done at the same time.

- 2.**Solar system report**: K. Carr reports that she and C. Joseph have completed their evaluation of the Rec Center Solar Energy system. Their written report was reviewed. R. Sorge moved that the report be forwarded to the Town Board. Seconded by K. Liggan-Casey. All in favor.
