TOWN BOARD WORKSHOP MEETING
MARCH 6, 2024

Supervisor Walsh called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM followed by the pledge. A moment of silence was observed for Lillian Barringer.

1. Speaker – Chief Scott Schaffrick said every year he submits a use of force report to the town. He said since 2020 he has incorporated that into an annual report. He said the purpose of the report is that it gives more insight of what happens in the Police Department. The annual report was submitted to the Police Commission and approved. Once the Town Board reviews and approves it he said it will go on the Police Facebook page and asked to have it on the Town Website. Chief Schaffrick said there were 4,200 calls last year and sees exceeding that this year. The criminal cases are slightly above where the town was in 2020. There were only 4 cases of use of force in the town. The Police survey that is put out by the Police Commission and received 2 back. He also discussed the training to be done for the officers and with the Town of Ulster.

Resolution 03-2024-#5 – Supervisor Walsh made a motion that the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale hereby approves the Short-Term Transient Rental Application along with the House Rules, 2nd by Councilmember Wykoff. ROLL VOTE: 4 YES, Councilmember Wykoff, Councilmember Sweeney, Councilmember Craven and Supervisor Walsh. 1 NO, Councilman Havranek.
7. Resolution 03-2024-#6 – Supervisor Walsh made a motion that the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale hereby authorizes the Supervisor to sign the agreement between the Town of Rosendale and Employee Assistance Program Services of the Mid-Hudson Valley, 2nd by Councilmember Wykoff. ROLL VOTE: 5 YES.
8. Resolution 03-2024-#7 – Supervisor Walsh made a motion that the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale hereby authorizes the Supervisor to sign the agreement with Schmidt's Wholesale Inc., 2nd by Councilman Havranek. ROLL VOTE: 5 YES.
