**RESOLUTION – LOCAL LAW #6 - CAMPS**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Rosendale has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to update its Zoning Law to provide for the siting and operation of Camps, Campground and/or Camping Uses; and

**WHEREAS**, a Local Law #6 to place a moratorium on such uses, entitled “A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR A MORATORIUM ON ACTIONS SUBJECT TO BUILDING PERMITS, SITE PLAN OR SPECIAL USE PERMIT REVIEW FOR APPLICATIONS RELATED TO CAMP, CAMPGROUND AND/OR CAMPING USES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS” was presented to the Town Board at a Town Board meeting held on May 1, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, this is a Type 2 action pursuant to SEQRA (6 NYCRR 617) resulting in no Environmental review being required; and

**WHEREAS** the Town Board forwarded the proposed local law to the Town of Rosendale Planning Board and the Ulster County Planning Board for recommendations; and

**WHEREAS** the Town Planning Board had no recommendations and the Ulster County Planning Board advised that the local law had no County Impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, a duly noticed public hearing was held on June 5, 2024.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Local Law #6 annexed hereto and entitled “A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR A MORATORIUM ON ACTIONS SUBJECT TO BUILDING PERMITS, SITE PLAN OR SPECIAL USE PERMIT REVIEW FOR APPLICATIONS RELATED TO CAMP, CAMPGROUND AND/OR CAMPING USES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS” is hereby adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Town Clerk be directed to file this Local Law #6 with the New York Secretary of State.

**RESOLUTION – INTER-MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH ULSTER COUNTY FOR LIFEGUARDS**

**WHEREAS**, on July 5, 2024, the Ulster County pool was closed due to prolonged loss of water resulting from unforeseen maintenance issues; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the pool closure, the Town of Rosendale has experienced an increase in the number of individuals seeking access to the Town of Rosendale pool; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Rosendale has the need for additional lifeguards to ensure appropriate staffing levels at the Pool based on the increased attendance rates and to increase the operating capacity of the pool; and

**WHEREAS**, to increase the operating capacity of the Town of Rosendale pool and ensure appropriate staffing due to increased attendance rates, the Town of Rosendale wishes to enter into an inter-municipal agreement with Ulster County to provide lifeguard services to the Town of Rosendale.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Rosendale hereby authorizes the Town Supervisor to enter into an inter-municipal agreement with the Ulster County to provide staffing services in order to meet the staffing needs at the Town of Rosendale pool.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this is contingent upon review & approval by the attorney for the Town.
