Problem

Existing radio system is analog (rebroadcast) Not suited for county-wide communication

Solution

Move to simulcast system covers a wider geographic area with broadcasts from multiple transmitter sites and is frequency efficient

Problem

Critical Coverage Gaps towers must talk to each other

Solution

Close Coverage gaps with additional towers improve existing towers and create backhaul redundancy






VHF Simulcast 95% Mobile Out Bound Coverage

- The tower design will allow collocation of cell carriers






Establishing Tower Height






Balance of Public Interest Test

Who Decides?

Balance of Public Interest Test- Items to be considered

- 1. The nature and scope of the instrumentality seeking immunity
- 2. The encroaching government's legislative grant of authority;
- 3. The kind of function or land use involved;
- 4. The effect local land use regulation would have upon the enterprise concerned;
- 5. Alternative locations for the facility in less restrictive zoning areas;
- 6. The impact upon legitimate local interests;
- 7. Alternative methods of providing the proposed improvement;
- 8. The extent of the public interest to be served by the improvements; and
- 9. Intergovernmental participation in the project development process and an opportunity to be heard.
